Connecting With Community

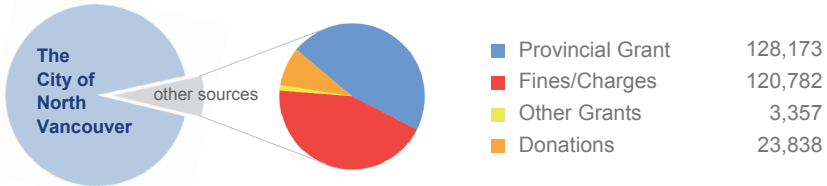
- Participated in CNV4ME youth taskforce

Connecting Through Technology

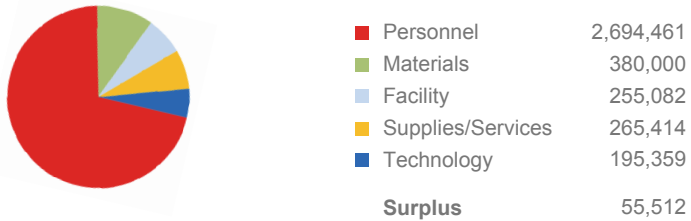
- Participated in the North Shore Business Expo
