Just in time to go back to school, create your own re-usable notebook cover! A cloth cover will make your notebooks unique and keep them tidy.

This project is beginner-friendly: we'll learn a few skills like turning corners, pinning and back-stitching. We'll make a notebook cover the right size for an 8" x 10" notebook, but it can be re-used for a smaller size, too.

Registration is required and supplies will be provided (including a notebook). All participants must be 13 years of age to use a sewing machine on their own. If you want to bring your own supplies, they will need to be approved by staff.

Please note: The library sewing machines can be operated without the use of a foot pedal by using the stop/start button instead.
