Nicole is a member of the Squamish Nation and practices a variety of traditional indigenous material practices. The ocean is very important and vital for Coast Salish communities and many have ceremonies or cultural practices surrounding the ocean as well as the sea life. One example is the Squamish Nation having an annual Honouring the Salmon Ceremony, to thank the fish and pray for their annual return. Fish leather was used for clothing items such as shoes as well as, pouches or used for decorative purposes.
