This class is open to sewists ages 10 – 16. Note: everyone under 13 (aged 10 - 12) attending the class must have an adult caregiver to stay and sew with them.

In this class, we will be learning to use two tools: [the Cricut Maker](#), including the Cricut Design Space app, and [Janome 2030 QDC B and DC G sewing machines](#). You can find more information about these tools at the links above.

Materials will be provided. If you would like to bring your own materials, they will require approval from the instructors.

Accessibility: North Vancouver City Library's sewing machines can be operated without a foot pedal – each machine can be operated with hands using the start/stop button.
