Sabina Khan is the acclaimed author of *What A Desi Girl Wants*, *Meet Me In Mumbai*, *Zara Hossain Is Here* and *The Love And Lies Of Rukhsana Ali*. She has lived in Germany, Bangladesh, Macao, Illinois and Texas before finally settling down in Vancouver, BC.
