Submission categories

- Photographs
- 2D art, including digital art

Work will be judged based on adherence to criteria, theme, originality, quality of technique and creativity. Submitted work may be used by City Library for promotional materials in print and online.

Photos or images may be submitted in a digital file. Take care to ensure images are of high quality for printing or on-screen display. The image should be 300dpi at a size of 8.5 x 11 inches, or 2,400 x 3,600 pixels. Your image attachment file size should be at least 8MB for grayscale, and 24MB for colour. The images will be printed on photo paper.

Criteria

- Open to all youth in grades 6 to 12 who live on the North Shore
- Limit of one entry per person
- Submitted work should have been created during the pandemic (2020 now)
- Submitters should have full copyright for the work produced (including permissions from

subjects in the piece if applicable)
