Read every day for 50 days, collect stickers, then join us at the library to receive your medal! Check back later this summer for more details about this event.

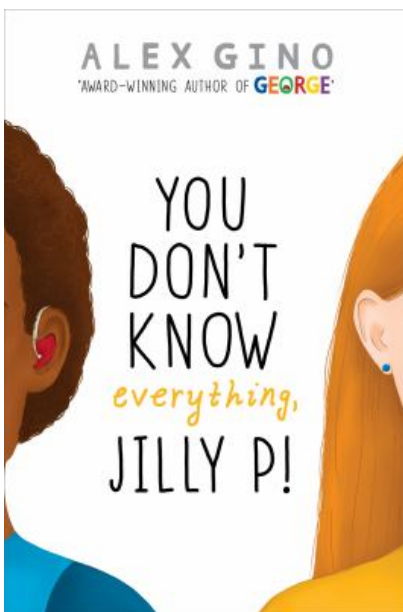
