## Levels of giving and recognition

### Donor recognition

City Library's donor recognition program aims to recognize and acknowledge the contributions of our many donors and supporters. All donations of \$25 or more receive a charitable tax receipt, letter of thanks, recognition in the annual community report and on the website.

Donors may elect to remain anonymous and may decline private or public recognition.

## **Gratitude wall**

Donations of \$100 or more are displayed on the library's gratitude wall, located inside the entrance to the library building. Eligible donors appear on the wall for a period of years following their donation. The wall panels are updated annually.

- Name displayed on gratitude wall for two years

#### **Sustainer \$2,500 – \$4,999**

- Name displayed on gratitude wall for four years
- Acknowledgement in community report

#### **Benefactor \$5,000 – \$9,999**

- Name displayed on gratitude wall for five years
- Acknowledgement in community report

#### **Champion \$10,000 – \$24,999**

- Name displayed on gratitude wall for seven years
- Acknowledgement in community report

- Acknowledgement in community report
