The City Library building will close all day Tuesday, Dec. 10, due to a [planned BC Hydro power outage](#).

A selection of library services and programs will be offered at North Vancouver City Hall, adjacent to the library building at 141 West 14th St. Holds pickup will be available at the library entrance until 4 p.m. only. Regular operations are expected to resume at our usual location Wednesday, Dec. 11 at 9 a.m.
